- **Wolfs: Second Grade (7-8)** Blue uniform shirt, Wolf hat, Yellow Neckerchief, Slide, and blue Belt.
- **Bears: Third Grade (8-9)** Blue uniform shirt, Bear hat, Blue Neckerchief, Slide, and blue Belt.
- **Webelos 1. Forth Grade (9-10)** Option of Blue or Tan uniform shirt, Webelos hat, Plaid neckerchief, and Slide.
- **Webelos 2. Fifth Grade (10-11)** Option of Blue or Tan uniform shirt, Webelos hat, Plaid neckerchief, and Slide.

### Uniforms:

All uniforms need the following patches: NCAC on the shoulder, Pack numerals 202, the World Crest Emblem, and the appropriate handbook.

Short sleeve shirts are the best bet. In colder weather, the Cubs can wear a long sleeved shirt under it. The Switchback pants are great, blue jeans, or shorts can be worn for the pants.

### Meetings:
